**What classes can I take to fulfill the diversity/humanity/3hr IMC/Jour/Mktg credit?**

Click on the class requirement in left column such as “arrow 1” that is displayed in the picture. “6 hrs. of humanities”. This person has fulfilled their credit with Engl 223 & His 105. If they needed to find classes to fulfil this credit, they would click the “Qualifying Academic Work” check box as displayed by arrow 2.

Arrow (3) displays all of the qualifying coursed that can satisfy the humanities requirement. All courses are not offered each semester so it is important to identify the classes you can take by searching what’s available in each term.
