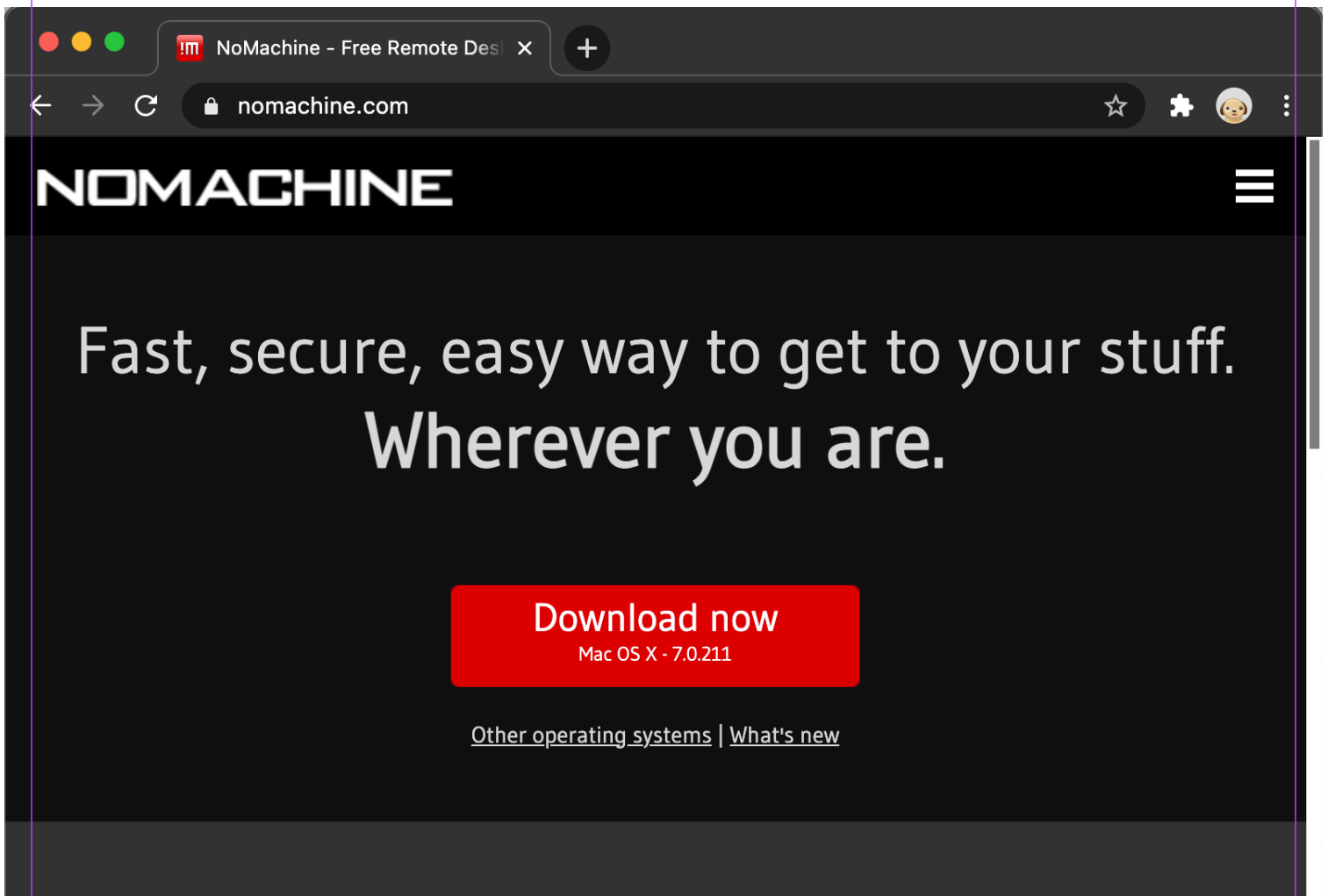

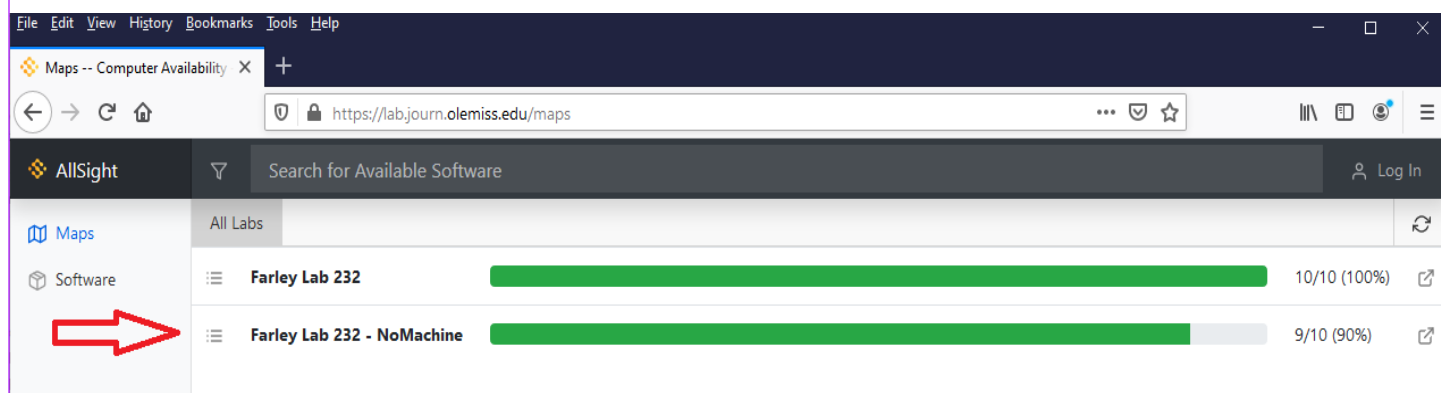

First download and install the proper [NoMachine](#) client for your device.

1. Click on a Lab that has - NoMachine (bottom green bar)

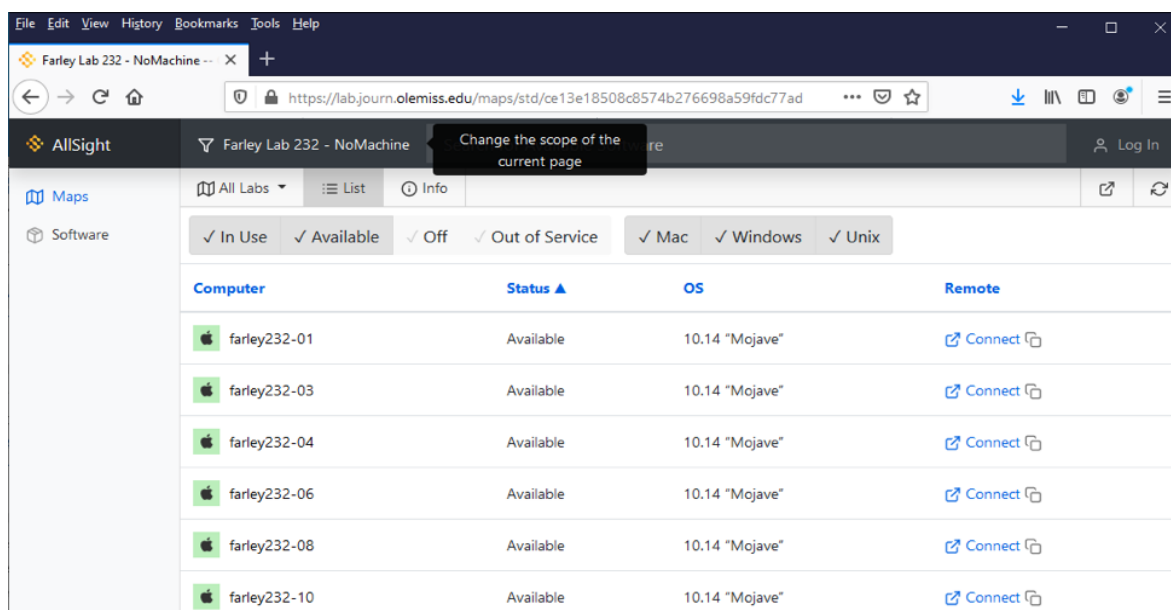


2. You are now viewing all iMacs within that lab.

Blue icon: Offline

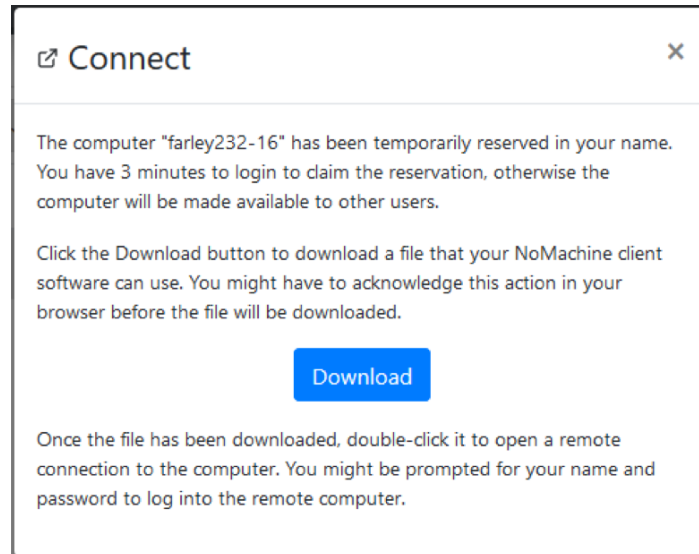
Green icon: Available

Red icon: In Use



3. Select an available machine by clicking on Connect in the Remote column.

4. The following box pops up:

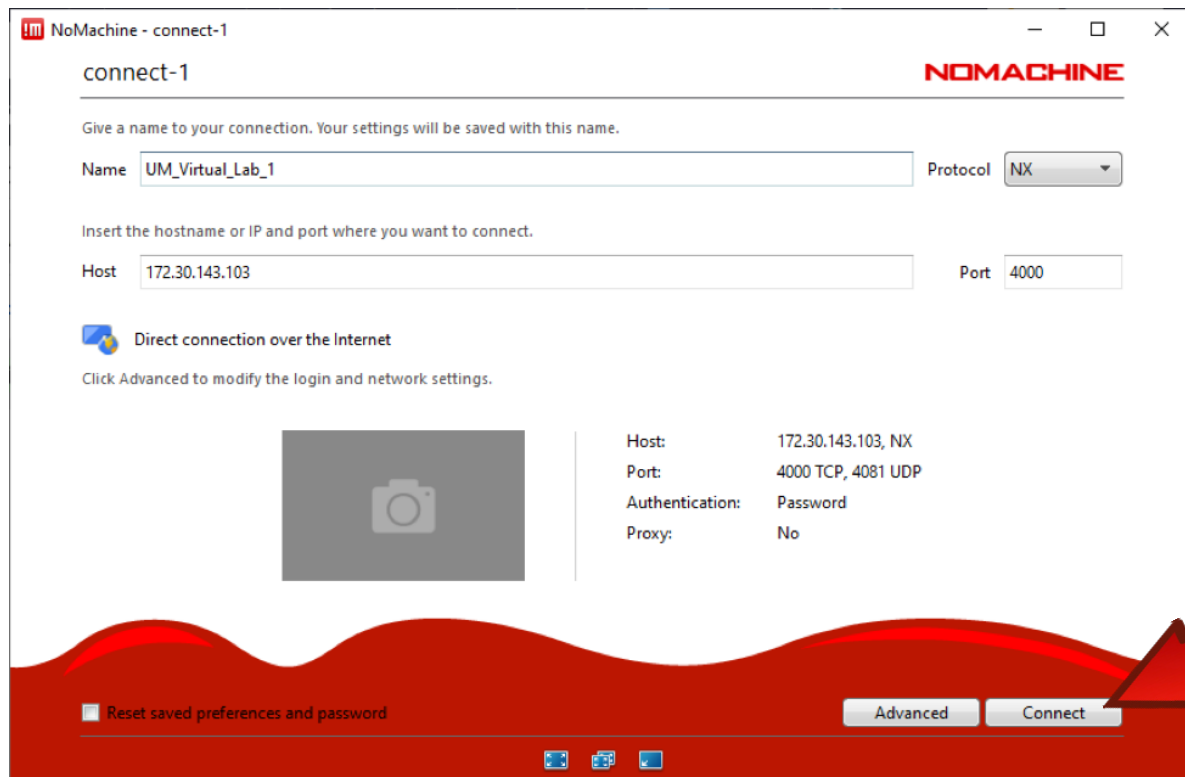


Click on Download
Open the file with NoMachine

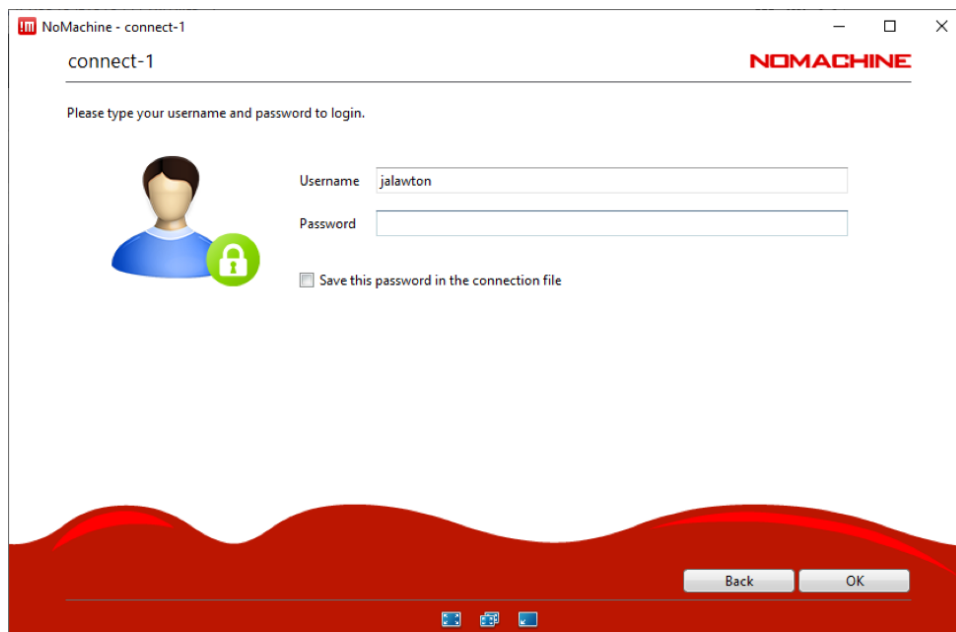
5. Choose "Yes"



6. Press "Connect"



7. Enter your Ole Miss login information then hit "OK"



You now virtually have access to a iMac in Farley Hall! You may use it just as if you were in the Farley Hall lab. Log in with your MyOleMiss credentials.

Before You Leave

Double click the “Log Out and Protect Yourself” Icon to log out when you complete your session. Then you may close out of the viewer app.

Failure to do log out will cause your session to remain active and hinder other students using this service.
